Friday – Breakouts and Closeout

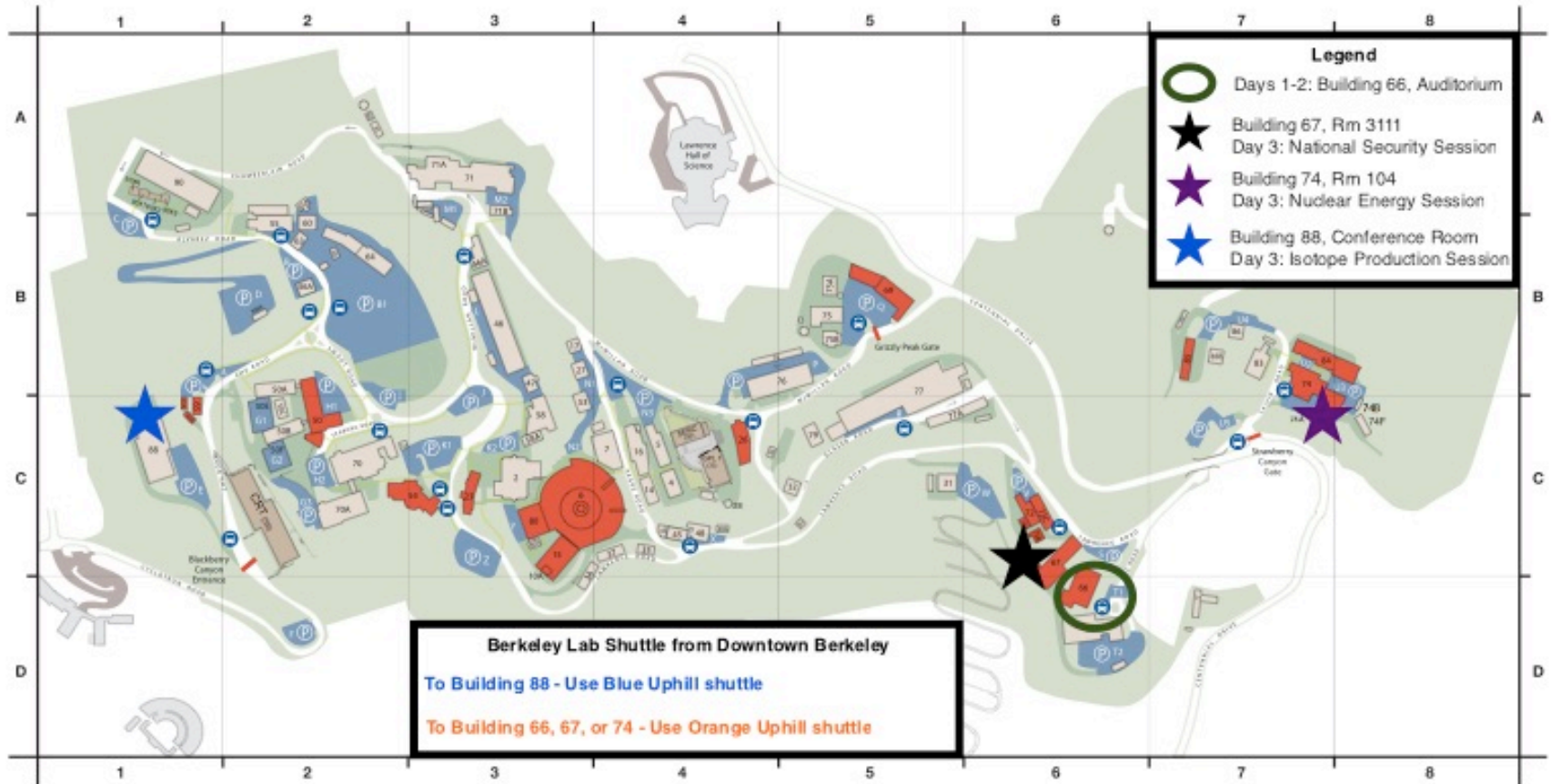
Purpose:

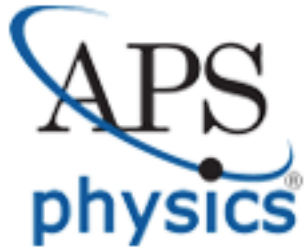
